The above chart reflects California's FMAP rates from 10/01/00 through 09/30/06. It is based on the Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) which begins 10/01 through 09/30. The FMAP rate is applied to all group homes and Foster Family Agencies (FFAs) statewide. County Welfare Departments (CWD) make payments to group home providers based on the Rate Classification Level (RCL) then, claim costs back to California Department of Social Services (CDSS) and are reimbursed based on the above FMAP rate.
