## Extraordinary Circumstances (Exemption 2)

	The IHSS provider must work for two or more IHSS recipients;
	All possible options for finding another provider must have been explored and exhausted by both the recipient and the county;
	All Recipients the provider works for must meet <u>at least one</u> of the following conditions:
	Criteria A: Have complex medical and/or behavioral needs that must be met by a provider who lives in the same home as the recipient.
Exemption Criteria	Criteria B: Live in a rural or remote area where available providers are limited and as a result the recipient is unable to hire another provider.
	Criteria C: Be unable to hire a provider who speaks his/her same language in order to direct his/her own care.
	Under Criteria A, the IHSS provider <u>must</u> live in the same home as the recipient(s) applying for Exemption 2 under this condition.
	Under Criteria B and C, the IHSS provider is not required to live in the same home as the recipient(s) applying for Exemption 2 under these conditions.
Maximum Hours	Up to 360 hours per month, up to 90 hours per week <u>combined</u> for all the recipients.
