SUBJECT: TELECONFERENCE: IHSS PROGRAM INTEGRITY AND FRAUD
PREVENTION STAKEHOLDER PROCESS

The purpose of this letter is to extend an invitation to your organizations to participate in the California Department of Social Services (CDSS) teleconference to discuss the upcoming Program Integrity and Fraud Prevention stakeholder workgroup process.

The purpose of the Program Integrity and Fraud Prevention stakeholder workgroup is to advise CDSS in the development of uniform statewide protocols and procedures that clarify state/county roles and responsibilities and acceptable activities to be performed for purposes of fraud prevention. The resulting protocols will guide the implementation of anti-fraud activities such as targeted mailings to persons that do not appear to have complied with program requirements and the unannounced home visits to verify receipt of services. These activities are pursuant to 2009/10 state budget trailer bills, Assembly Bills 4 and 19 of the Fourth Extraordinary Legislative Session of 2009 (Chapters 4 and 17, respectively).
