

Chapter Six: CalFresh Reporting for Older Adults

Currently, most CalFresh recipients are required to complete a Quarterly Report (QR7) every three months to report their income and expenses. By October 1, 2013, all California counties will be moving to semi-annual reporting. However, households with seniors are exempt from quarterly and semi-annual reporting if they do not have earnings; they are considered Change Reporting households and are simply required to report changes to income, household composition, and address within 10 days by using form DFA 377.5, the Food Stamp Household Change Report.³² Changes can be reported using this form in person or by phone. Note that older adults who are self-employed still need to submit a QR7.
