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## A brief background of the Yolo County CNAP

- Quarterly meetings since 2012, facilitated by the Yolo County SNAP-Ed Program
- Over 20 partners Some unique players
  - Department of Agriculture
  - County Supervisor staff
  - Dairy Council of CA
  - Community-based organizations working on farm to fork
- Food access for SNAP-eligible is a key initiative
- Many partners affiliated with the farm to fork movement











### Harvest of the Month (HOTM): A campaign to rally around

- Why HOTM?
  - Established campaign
  - Ties in local agriculture
  - USDA approved
  - Simple for consumer









#### Farm to Fork Successes within CNAP

- HOTM promotion: partner training, community taste tests, and retail presence
- Increase in fresh produce at food distributions and use in schools (cafeteria, kids' farmer's markets)
- Yolo Farm to School Harvest Hub, improved farmer/institution relationships, common language
- Taste tests targeting SNAP eligible residents and programs








# Novel way to reach SNAP eligible residents with Farm to Fork: Yolo FRESHTEXT
