**Homeless? Facing an Eviction? Staying in a Shelter?
There May Be Help Available!**

Yolo County recently received an allocation of funding to provide housing assistance to families that are homeless or facing an eviction. You may be eligible if you:

- ◆ Live in Yolo County and plan to stay here
- ◆ Receive CalWORKs, or are eligible to CalWORKs if you do not currently receive it
- ◆ Your children live with you, or would be able to live with you if you had stable housing
- ◆ You have already received or are currently receiving your once in a lifetime CalWORKs Homeless Assistance Payment
- ◆ One of these describes your current housing situation:
 - ◆ You have no permanent place to sleep at night
 - ◆ Are staying in a shelter
 - ◆ Camping or staying in parks or other public places
 - ◆ Have received an eviction notice
 - ◆ Are staying in a hotel/motel but cannot continue to do so
 - ◆ Are staying with friends or relatives but cannot continue to do so

If you are eligible, the CalWORKs Housing Support Allocation can:

- ◆ Help you find a safe, affordable and permanent place to live
- ◆ Contact landlords to explain how the program works
- ◆ Assist with required application or credit check fees
- ◆ Rent assistance, including lot rental for RV or manufactured home
- ◆ Assist with the security deposit and last month's rent if required
- ◆ Assist with gas, electric and other essential move-in costs
- ◆ Provide a housing support case manager to help you with every step of the process and develop a plan for long term housing stability.

Once your housing is stable, you will work closely with your case manager to resolve problem situations and find employment so that you can keep your home after the rental assistance ends.
