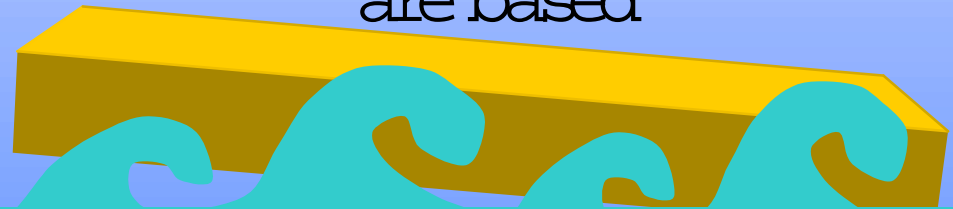

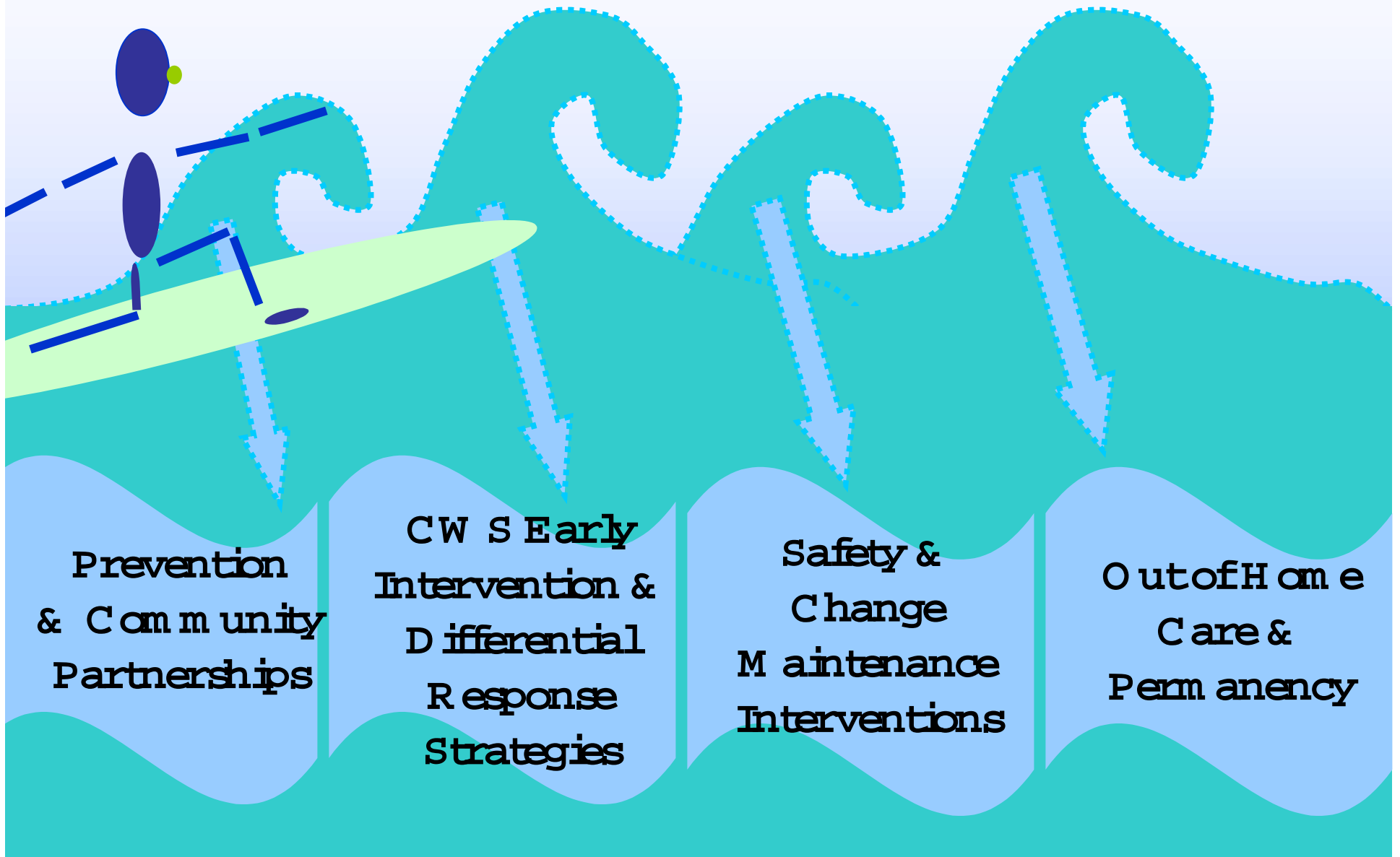

Prevention & Community Partnerships	CWS Early Intervention & Differential Response	Safety & Change Maintenance Interventions	Out of Home Care & Permanency
Focused on partnering with the community to strengthen and support families <i>before</i> they come to the attention of CWS	Ensures that customized, substantive response is provided to families <i>as soon as</i> they are identified to CWS	Centers on ensuring that child safety is the priority and determines how families will be served <i>once they enter</i> the CWS System	Will assist children and families to <i>exit</i> CWS through early reunification when possible, or urgency in achieving alternative permanency

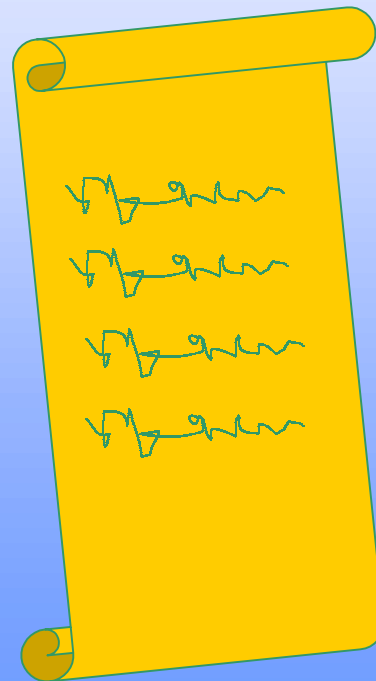
