



Lindsay woman sentenced for welfare fraud

Ysabel Lopez, 27 of Lindsay, was sentenced to 60 days in county jail and five years formal probation for illegally obtaining \$4,022 through fraud. Lopez pled no contest to one count of felony welfare fraud which arose from her receipt of aid by misrepresentation.

An investigation revealed that between July 6 and Oct. 31, Lopez made false statements to receive undue compensation.

As a condition of her probation, Lopez is required to pay full restitution to the Tulare County Health and Human Services Agency.
