The purpose of this notice is to provide you with additional information regarding the regulations regarding fleeing felons, convicted drug felons, and probation and parole violators, transmitted with All-County Information Notice 1-49-00. These regulations have been filed with the Secretary of State and are effective July 1, 2000.

The regulation package transmitted to you with ACIN 1-49-00 contained a reference to the state definition of controlled substance (Division 10 of the Health and Safety Code, commencing with Section 11007). Although this definition is still applicable, the reference was deleted in the final regulation package that was filed with the Secretary of State.
