## SUBJECT: DISASTER GUIDANCE ATTACHMENT – DISASTER SUPPLEMENTAL NUTRITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM INCOME ELIGIBILITY STANDARDS AND ALLOTMENTS – EFFECTIVE **OCTOBER 1, 2015**

This letter informs counties that the United States Department of Agriculture, Food and Nutrition Service (FNS) has issued the Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2015 Disaster Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (D-SNAP) Income Eligibility Standards and Allotments for the period of October 1, 2015 through September 30, 2016.

The computation below shows how FNS computes the Disaster Gross Income limits for a one-person household:

Household Size	Inclusions	Allotments
One-person	Maximum Monthly Net Income Limit for household size of one (100% of FPL)	+ \$981
One-person	Maximum Standard Income Deduction	+ \$155
One-person	Maximum Shelter Expense Deduction	+ \$504
One-person	Disaster Gross Income Limit	= \$1640

Each Additional Member	+\$347	+\$146

## 48 States and DC

1 These figures include all necessary calculations. For example, for a 1-person household in the 48 States and DC, the maximum net monthly income = \$981; standard deduction = \$155; maximum shelter deduction = \$504. \$981 + \$155 + \$504 = \$1640.
