This All County Letter (ACL) changes the California Department of Social Services' (CDSS) policy regarding the administrative review authorized by Manual of Policies and Procedures (MPP) section 22-009.2 for In-Home Supportive Services (IHSS) cases. The policy contained in this ACL supersedes the policies regarding the jurisdiction of Administrative Law Judges to review claims for IHSS benefits set forth on page five of ACL No. 10-61 (December 17, 2010) under the heading "State Hearings," and on page seven of ACL No. 13-47 (June 7, 2013) under the heading "State Hearings."

#### **BACKGROUND**

The MPP section 22-009 sets forth the time limit for applicants or recipients of public social services to request a state hearing. The CDSS previously issued policies limiting the applicability of MPP section 22-009.2 to IHSS cases.

#### **POLICY CHANGE**

All previous policies limiting the administrative review authorized by MPP section 22-009.2 with regard to claims for IHSS benefits are hereby rescinded. This regulation section relates to the jurisdiction of Administrative Law Judges to review recipients' benefits.
