SUBJECT: IMPLEMENTATION OF THE NEW STATEWIDE MINIMUM WAGE

REFERENCE: ASSEMBLY BILL 10 (CHAPTER 351, STATUTES OF 2013);
California Labor Code Section 1182.12

This notice is to inform counties of Assembly Bill 10 (AB 10) (Chapter 351, Statutes of 2013), which was enacted on September 25, 2013. AB 10 amended Section 1182.12 of the California Labor Code by increasing the minimum wage for all industries to \$9.00 per hour effective on and after July 1, 2014. Additionally, the minimum wage for all industries shall not be less than \$10.00 per hour on and after January 1, 2016.

Counties with an In-Home Supportive Services provider wage less than \$9.00 per hour (as of June 30, 2014) are required to submit a PA Rate Change Request along with all necessary documents and signatures to the California Department of Social Services (CDSS), Systems and Administrative Branch, no later than May 1, 2014.

The county Board of Supervisors approval will not be required for the minimum-wage increase. However, if the PA Rate Change Request provides for an increase in wages above the \$9.00 per hour wage, or provides for an increase in the other components (i.e., payroll taxes, health benefits, or administrative costs) the Board of Supervisors' approval will be required by CDSS and the Department of Health Care Services.
