The purpose of this notice is to inform the counties of the availability of a new California Department of Social Services (CDSS) form that counties may use at their discretion. The Notice of Language Services (GEN 1365 Multilingual) provides information to clients who have limited English-speaking abilities of the availability of interpretative services if they do not understand the county notices that have been sent to them. The information is listed in 13 different languages. The GEN 1365 form <http://www.dss.cahwnet.gov/cdssweb/entres/forms/ulti/GEN1365MUL.pdf> replaces the DEP 3006, which some counties may be using. The DEP 3006 was not developed for county use, but rather for state-only use with cases requiring a state disability determination.
