TO: ALL COUNTY WELFARE DIRECTORS

SUBJECT: ADDITIONAL COUNTY EDITING PROCEDURE FOR TITLE XX SOCIAL SERVICES
STATISTICAL REPORTS (FORM SOC 242)REFERENCE: MANUAL OF POLICIES AND PROCEDURES, STATISTICAL REPORTS,
SECTION 26-514.01

A review of Form SOC 242, Title XX Social Services Statistical Reports, shows that some counties have been making certain types of errors on the reports that they have been submitting to the Statistical Services Bureau. In order to reduce the number of such errors, we are planning to add to the edit guide the following new edit.

No entry in any cell on Form 2A or 2B -- excluding the "Total" line at the top and the total column (the left-hand column on Form 2A) -- can be greater than the entry in the corresponding total line on Form 1. See attached examples of edit exceptions on sample report forms. Notice that the circled entries on Form 2A in each case are greater than the corresponding entry on the "Total" line on Form 1. One of these entries (or both) should be regarded as an error, and appropriate corrections made by the county to bring them into agreement so as to meet this edit before submittal to Sacramento.

The edit will read:


Forms 1 and 2A and 2B:

Are all of the entries on Form 2A and 2B (except for those in the Total line at the top and the total column at the left-hand side of Form 2A) equal to or less than the corresponding entry on Form 1 on the Total line? Yes No

Please observe this edit on the reports that you submit for the January-March 1980 report quarter and subsequent reports. This new edit will be added to the Edit Guide as soon as administratively feasible.
