ALL-COUNTY INFORMATION NOTICE I- 121-81

TO: ALL COUNTY WELFARE DIRECTORS

SUBJECT: REDUCTION OF TITLE XX REPORTING REQUIREMENT ON FORM 5, DAY CARE SERVICES PROVIDED TO CHILDREN, (FORM SOC 242, PAGE 7).

REFERENCE: DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES MANUAL OF POLICY AND PROCEDURES, SECTION 26-514.

Effective July 1, 1981, Title XX funds will no longer be used to purchase day care services provided through the State Department of Education. Therefore, beginning with the July-September, 1981 report quarter, counties will not be required to submit a copy of the Form 5 to the Department of Education, as indicated in the instructions on the form.


However, counties are to continue to submit Form 5 to the Statistical Services Branch, Department of Social Services; completing only the information for Title IV-B CWS (in column erroneously printed on the form as "IV-R").

Counties are to continue to provide the information required on Forms 1, 2A, and 3A relating to the provision of Title XX Child Day Care Case Management Services.

In view of potential changes by the Federal Government, the Department of Social Services will be reviewing the SSRR reporting requirements.
