SUBJECT: BAKER V. PROD: IDENTIFICATION OF AFFECTED CASES IN AFDC

REFERENCE: ALL-COUNTY INFORMATION NOTICE I-21-83, ALL COUNTY LETTER 83-14

As you were informed in the above referenced letters, a preliminary injunction was issued February 9, 1983, in the case of <u>Baker v. Prod.</u> In this action, plaintiffs seek to make retroactive the decision reached in the case of <u>Turner v. Woods</u>, which stated that mandatory payroll deductions must be subtracted from gross income prior to allowance of disregards. The injunction requires counties to take immediate action and follow specific procedures in identifying affected applicants and recipients.

The injunction also requires counties to submit statements on the steps taken to comply and specific tallies on the number of persons identified as potential claimants. This letter transmits two forms for reporting these required statements and an optional form for county use in gathering information. The forms are described below.

ATTACHMENT I is to be used to submit information required by paragraph C, page 5 of the preliminary injunction. The completed form must be submitted to SDSS no later than March 14, 1983. Moreover, counties should include a copy of the CA-7 stuffer and posted notice used by the county.

ATTACHMENT II is to be used to submit information required by paragraph D, page 6 of the preliminary injunction. This form requires reporting tallies of potential claimants. Counties should take care to avoid counting applicants/recipients in more than one category. The completed form must be submitted to SDSS no later than May 23, 1983.

ATTACHMENT III is provided for county use only in tracking applicant and redetermination cases affected by the $\underline{Baker\ v.\ Prod}$ injunction. Use of this form is optional. It should not be sent to SDSS.
