TO: ALL COUNTY WELFARE DIRECTORS

SUBJECT: Training on the Emergency Assistance Program

REFERENCE: MPP Section 30-182

The current Emergency Assistance (EA) Program is being restructured. This is to advise you that the Foster Care Program Bureau will be conducting regional training sessions on the restructured EA program as described in Manual of Policies and Procedures (MPP) Section 30-182. The EA regulations will be filed on an emergency basis. We anticipate that these regulations will be effective on January 1, 1987,


This one-day training workshop is designed to give your staff practical experience and information that will facilitate effective implementation of the EA regulations. The sessions will consist of a brief introduction, an overview of the EA program, an explanation of each program component and a walk-through of the EA application process. It is our goal that upon completion of the training session, your staff will have a practical understanding of the restructured EA program and the application process.

The county representatives who would benefit most from the training include:

1. Persons who are responsible for training the social workers who make initial Emergency Response contacts.
2. Persons who are responsible for developing county procedures.
3. Services supervisors who will be responsible for overseeing the EA program.

Attached to this letter is the training session schedule containing the date, time and location of each session. necn11e of the workshop nature of the sessions, we request that attendance at any one session be limited to a maximum of 36 participants. For this reason, it is important that only the specified number of participants from your county attend the session assigned. However, in the event your staff are unable to attend the assigned session, please let us know. We will attempt to make alternate arrangements for participation in another session depending on space availability.
