The purpose of this errata is to correct the attachments to the above referenced All-County Information Notices (ACINs).

Based on preliminary information not reverified prior to the release of the August 1988 Corrective Action Plan Progress Report, Merced County's AFDC error rate for the period of October 1987 through March 1988 was listed as 4.1 percent. The correct AFDC error rate for Merced is 2.2 percent. As this error rate is below the Federal tolerance standard of 3.0, Merced is not an intensive focus County, as erroneously stated in the Report. Additionally, Merced County's error rate was similarly misstated in the ACIN transmitting County AFDC and Food Stamp error rates.

Enclosed are revised copies of Charts 8 and 9 (pages 12 and 13) of the AFDC Quality Control/Corrective Action Progress Report (ACIN I-90-88), and the attachment to ACIN I-103-88 reflecting the correct information. Please insert these corrected pages in your copies of both items. The Corrective Action Bureau will take steps to ensure that the most accurate and up-to-date information is reflected in our letters highlighting County performance.
