TO: ALL COUNTY WELFARE DIRECTORS

SUBJECT: REFERRAL RESOURCES FOR CHILD ABUSE/CHILD WELFARE
SERVICES ISSUES ON MILITARY INSTALLATIONS

As you may be aware, there is little or no authority on a State or County level to intervene in child abuse/child welfare cases on military installations. The purpose of this letter is to provide you with an update to referral resources available for dealing with child abuse/child welfare issues on military installations.

All-County Information Notice I-106-88, dated October 25, 1988 advised you of two resources. Please be advised that the name and address of both resources have changed. Both the first and second resources are listed below with their correct addresses and telephone numbers.
