SUBJECT: ESTABLISHMENT OF THE CHILD CARE PROGRAMS UNIT

This is to inform you that our Department has recently established a centralized Child Care Programs Unit within the Employment Programs Branch in order to address current and future child care issues. It is our hope that this restructuring will provide a more coordinated approach in the delivery of child care services at the local level.

Effective immediately, the policy and regulations development and the implementation and interpretation of all child care programs will be transferred into the Child Care Programs Unit. This unit will be supervised by Ms. Charr Lee Metsker, and have the responsibility for the following:

- Transitional Child Care (TCC) Program
- "At Risk" Child Care Program
- GAIN Child Care
- Miller Lawsuit and Implementation
- Federal Child Care and Development Block Grant
- Welfare Reform Child Care Issues:
  - Cal Learn Initiative Child Care
  - AFDC Job Club Child Care
