SUBJECT: Earned Income Credit (EIC) Survey

REFERENCES: All-County Information Notice (ACIN) I-04-94

The purpose of this letter is to survey those agencies involved in the campaign to increase the claiming of EIC by low income families.

On February 1, 1994 the California Department of Social Services (CDSS) issued ACIN I-04-94 which provided information and materials on a national EIC Outreach Campaign. In addition to the standard ACIN distribution, copies were sent to child welfare services program managers, public and private adoption agencies, the CDSS' adoptions district offices, and all licensed foster family agencies. We also sent a stuffer with the April Medi-Cal cards to AFDC recipients, foster parents and adoptive parents.

A Medi-Cal mailing may not be feasible for next year's campaign because of the conversion to plastic Medi-Cal cards. As a result we hope to get an early start on other methods to distribute information on EIC. The attached survey will help us to prepare for the 1995 EIC campaign. 
