### MBSAC INCREASE

The purpose of this letter is to inform counties of an increase to the CalWORKs MBSAC levels effective July 1, 2008. W&I Code Section 11453 provides that the CalWORKs MBSAC levels shall be adjusted annually to reflect any increases or decreases in the cost of living. This year's COLA increases the MBSAC and Income In-Kind levels by 5.26 percent. The new MBSAC levels are to be used in determining applicant financial eligibility for those families that apply for CalWORKs on or after July 1, 2008.

The Maximum Aid Payment (MAP) COLA has been delayed until October 2008. Final instructions regarding the MAP levels for October 2008 forward will be issued in a separate letter once the Governor's Budget for Fiscal Year 2008-09 has been enacted.

The new CalWORKs MBSAC Payment Standards Chart for Region 1 and 2 is enclosed to assist in implementing these changes. New Income In-Kind levels are included in this chart as these amounts also increase as a result of the MBSAC COLA.

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# REFUGEE CASH ASSISTANCE (RCA) AND TRAFFICKING AND CRIME VICTIMS ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (TCVAP)

These implementation instructions for the MBSAC COLA and the Income In-Kind changes shall also apply to RCA and TCVAP applicants and recipients.
