SUBJECT: UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE BENEFIT INCREASES

REFERENCE:


This letter is to advise you of increases in the weekly benefit amounts received by claimants under the Unemployment Insurance Benefit (UIB) Program effective January 1, 1976. The increases affect only those claims filed effective January 4, 1976, and do not affect persons currently receiving UIB payments. The maximum weekly benefit amount has been increased from \$90 to \$104 and the minimum weekly benefit amount has been raised from \$25 to \$30. The increases will be reflected in all new UIB claims with an effective beginning date of January 4, 1976, or later and will be reflected in payments made to those claimants who file after that date. The earliest date that claimants can be expected to receive increased benefit amounts is January 19, 1976.

Eligibility staff should be informed of the new benefit amounts in order to incorporate them into grant determinations as soon as possible.

A schedule reflecting the new benefit amounts is attached.
