ALL-COUNTY LETTER NO. 77-27 (Adult Prog. Mgmt.)

TO: ALL COUNTY WELFARE DIRECTORS

SUBJECT: REPATRIATED AMERICANS PROGRAM

REFERENCE:

This is to clarify the procedures for granting, reporting and claiming assistance to Repatriated Americans as prescribed by MPP Division 68.

Continuing assistance granted to repatriated Americans is based on the SSI (not including SSP) standard of assistance (MPP Section 68-104.2). The SSI standard of assistance effective July 1, 1977, will be as follows:

	<u>Independent Living Arrangement</u>	<u>Living in the House- hold of Another</u>
Individual	\$177.80	\$118.54
Couple	\$266.70	\$177.80

Repatriated American cases involving escorts may require payment of per diem for the escort. Such per diem may be paid according to the U. S. Department of Health, Education and Welfare rates. In California, these rates currently are \$40 per day in Los Angeles, \$41 per day in San Francisco and Oakland, and \$35 per day in all other California areas.

The forms used for reporting and claiming are the APA-2061 and the APA-2048, respectively. Both forms should be directed to the Repatriate Program Consultant, Adult Program Management Branch, State Department of Benefit Payments, 744 P Street, Sacramento CA 95814, as specified in MPP Sections 68-106.6 and 68-106.7a. The mailing instructions contained in MPP 68-106.7b are in error and will be corrected as soon as possible.


The APA-2061 (Report on Referral) is to be completed whether or not assistance is given. It must be completed by the county making the initial contact with the repatriate and should be submitted not more than five days after initial contact has been made.

The APA-2061 is not a billing document; therefore, an APA-2048 (Expenditure Statement and Claim for Reimbursement) must be submitted for all months in which assistance has been given, including the month reported on the APA-2061 if assistance was given that month. The APA-2048 should be submitted by the fifth of each month, following county expenditures. If necessary, a supplemental APA-2048 may be submitted for a month already claimed. A supplemental APA-2048 must be clearly identified as supplemental and must include an explanation of the need for supplementation of the original claim. Any county expenditures listed as "other" on an APA-2048 must be fully explained on an attachment including cost of salaries, transportation, telephone, etc.

All APA-2061's and APA-2048's must be completed in quadruplicate; counties should retain one copy and submit three copies to SDBP. Each copy submitted to SDBP must carry the original signature of the appropriate county representative.

We believe that adherence to these procedures will ensure prompt and accurate reimbursement of county expenditures for Repatriated Americans. Any questions concerning the Repatriated Americans Program should be directed to the Repatriate Program Consultant at (916) 445-0813.
