ALL-COUNTY LETTER NO. 81-82

TO: ALL COUNTY WELFARE DIRECTORS

SUBJECT: FY 1981-82 ALLOCATION FOR 24-HOUR EMERGENCY RESPONSE SYSTEM

REFERENCE:

A FY 81/82 budget of \$8,405,078 has been approved for the statewide 24-hour emergency response system. Counties will be required to match these funds with a 25 percent county share of cost.

Budgeted funds have been distributed based on the methodology used last year. All counties' allocations include a base amount of \$10,000. The remainder of the \$8,405,078 has been divided on the basis of the number of children in each county aged 0 through 17. Individual county allocations are attached.

If an emergency response plan has not yet been submitted or approved by this department, emergency response funds cannot be used for reimbursement. Counties considering expansion of their program should assess the need to revise plans previously submitted. Additionally, counties which received one-year waivers should request extension of the waiver if it is still necessary.
