TO: ALL COUNTY WELFARE DIRECTORS

SUBJECT: REFUGEE RESETTLEMENT PROGRAM CASH GRANT CASELOAD MOVEMENT REPORT

REFERENCE: ALL-COUNTY LETTER 82-24

This letter is being issued to transmit revised instructions for the Refugee Resettlement Program Cash Grant Caseload Movement Report (RS 237).

The federal regulations, as contained in 45 CFR Parts 400 and 401, now limit the time-eligibility of individuals receiving Refugee Cash Assistance (RCA) to 18 months. Although no changes will be made to the RS 237 Form, the instructions will reflect the modifications. Columns 4, 5, and 6 for Items 9a and 9b should indicate those cases and persons that are ineligible for RCA due to the 18-months time-eligible limitation. Unaccompanied minors are not subject to the 18-month time limitation provision of RCA, but remain eligible until they attain the age of majority, as established by AFDC regulations. At such time, eligibility shall be considered under the time limitation provision.


Due to the recent court action of Hoang Ha v. Schweiker, the implementation of this change is effective with the April report month that is due May 20, 1982. The following instructions will be incorporated in the Statistical Reports Manual of Policy and Procedures. Items 9a and 9b of 26-213.30 will read:

- a. 36-months or 18-months time-expired cases. Enter the number of cases in columns 1, 2, and 3 in which aid to the entire case was terminated due to the 36-months time limitation. Enter the number of cases in columns 4, 5, and 6 in which aid to the entire case was terminated due to the 18-months time limitation.

- b. 36-months or 18-months time-expired persons. Enter the number of persons in columns 1, 2, and 3 whose aid was terminated due to the 36-months time limitation whether or not the entire case was discontinued. Enter the number of persons in columns 4, 5, and 6 whose aid was terminated due to the 18-months time limitation whether or not the case was discontinued.
