SUBJECT: SUSPENSION OF THE TRACKING PROCESS FOR SDE-SUBSIDIZED

CHILD CARE FOR ELIGIBLE RECIPIENTS

REFERENCE: ACL 86-93

The purpose of this letter is to suspend the child care tracking process outlined in All-County Letter (ACL) 86-93, dated September 10, 1986. This process was intended to track the cost of child care subsidized by the State Department of Education (SDE) which is provided to children of parents in employment programs which are eligible for Federal financial participation (FFP).

The suspension of this tracking process is consistent with the Supplemental Report of the 1988 State Budget Act. The tracking process may be resumed, or another developed in its place, in the event that more Greater Avenues for Independence (GAIN) components become eligible for FFP (as a result of the new Federal Welfare Reform Law) or at such time that a significant number of participants have reached the post-assessment eligible components and would make such tracking worthwhile.
