SUBJECT: STANDARD TELEPHONE ALLOWANCE IN FOOD STAMPS

REFERENCE: 63-502.352(b)

This letter is to inform County Welfare Departments that California's standard telephone allowance has been increased from \$6 to \$20 effective April 1, 1992.

A recent Departmental study revealed that current costs for telephone mandatory fees and basic service in most of California are between \$17.99 and \$19.58. Using this information, the Department requested and received approval from the Food and Nutrition Service to increase the standard telephone allowance to \$20 for California Food Stamp households.

Food Stamp Manual Section 63-502.352(b) will be changed to reflect the new standard telephone allowance in a future regulations package.
