SUBJECT: RESCINDING AUTHORIZATION TO RECEIVE FOSTER CARE

FUNDS FOR CALIFORNIA CHILDREN PLACED IN

- (1) AZELWAY, INC -- TEXAS
- (2) CHILDREN'S HOME OF DETROIT MICHIGAN
- PRAIRIE LEARNING CENTER NORTH DAKOTA

Azelway, Inc., Children's Home of Detroit, and Prairie Learning Center have advised the California Department of Social Services (CDSS) that they are no longer interested in certification as an out-of-state provider for the purpose of receiving California children as placements. Their applications for certification as out-of state providers for the purpose of receiving California children as foster care placements are withdrawn.

Under the authority of the Interstate Compact on the Placement of Children and as the Title IV-E single state agency authority, CDSS suspended, effective September 1, 1999, any new Interstate Compact placements from California in these facilities. There are no California children currently in Azelway, Inc., and Prairie Learning Center. There is one California child at the Children's Home of Detroit and Riverside County was notified by telephone on September 9, 1999, to make plans for the safe removal of the child.

As a result of this action, counties may no longer claim costs on any of the County Assistance Claims for New Placements at these facilities effective October 9, 1999. Any county that does not comply will be at risk of future audit exceptions.

Be advised that failure to obtain certification precludes placement of California children by county social services or probation departments. However, children who are seriously emotionally disturbed and placed pursuant to California Government Code Section 7570 et al. are not impacted by the certification process.
