**SUBJECT: ESTIMATED SHARING RATIOS FOR FISCAL YEAR (FY) 2011-12
CALIFORNIA WORK OPPORTUNITY AND RESPONSIBILITY TO KIDS
(CalWORKs) - CA 800 FEDERAL ASSISTANCE EXPENDITURES**

This letter informs counties of the estimated federal and state sharing ratio for the CalWORKs Assistance expenditures for FY 2011-12. Due to the complexities in Federal Welfare Reform laws, regulations and implementing legislation enacted by the state, the California Department of Social Services (CDSS) is unable to determine the actual segregation of the CalWORKs assistance amounts claimed on the CA 800 federal claim until after the close of the FY. The final federal and state sharing ratio letter for CalWORKs Assistance expenditures will be provided in December 2012.

Without actual data, it is recommended that counties estimate the federal, state, and county shares of CalWORKs assistance expenditures and revenues for FY 2011-12 using sharing ratios of 52.3 percent federal, 45.2 percent state, and 2.5 percent county. The CDSS did **not** use these ratios to determine your monthly assistance payments; therefore the amount of federal and state funds your counties received throughout the year may reflect a different sharing ratio.

To determine the amount of federal and state funds for the CalWORKs assistance program for year-end accrual purposes, please refer to the example on the following page.

County Fiscal Officers
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If the county's total FY 2011-12 CalWORKs assistance expenditures claimed on the CA 800 federal claim was \$1 million, the break down of the funding is as follows:

Total (100%)	Federal (52.3%)	State/County 2011 (45.2%)	County (2.5%)
\$1,000,000	\$523,000	\$452,000	\$25,000
