

Parent Leadership

A customized training and support program to develop the capacity and resilience of parents for the development of parents as leaders

In 2016, the Office of Child Abuse Prevention (OCAP) awarded Lead4Tomorrow - Family Hui, a three-year grant to support statewide parent leadership. The Family Hui program is a holistic peer-to-peer parent-strengthening program. The Hui will strengthen the capacity of parents to build resiliency in families, particularly for families over-represented in the child welfare system. The grant cycle will began in July 2016 and will conclude June 30, 2019.

Lead4Tomorrow - Family Hui, will build a statewide team of parent leaders, including those previously involved in the child welfare system, to actively participate in program planning, development of policies and procedures, evaluation of systems, etc., at both the state and local levels.

Lead4Tomorrow is a nonprofit organization dedicated to building resiliency in families and communities. The Family Hui will build upon a 30 year foundation of the former Hawai'i based Baby Hui organization. The Baby Hui program successfully organized community-based positive parenting peer groups since 1982.
