SITUATION:

HH consists of mom, dad and 7 children. Mom and dad are both timed out of CalWORKs and do not receive aid for themselves. There is also an MFG child in the home. They also have earnings for our sample month.

QUESTION:

How do we compute the answer for T26C2 and T26C4? For T26C2, do we start with the MAP for 9 and subtract from 8 and enter the answer? Are mom and dad part of the equation since they are timed out? I would think we would include them in the calculation for T26C2 and then T26C4 would be the MAP differential between the 8 remaining and the 6 actually receiving.

ANSWER:

Start at the beginning.

If the MFG child was born prior to the time out, then use the MAP differential between 9 and 8 for T26C2A. Then use the differential between 8 and 6 for T26C4A. And vice versa if that is the chronology.
