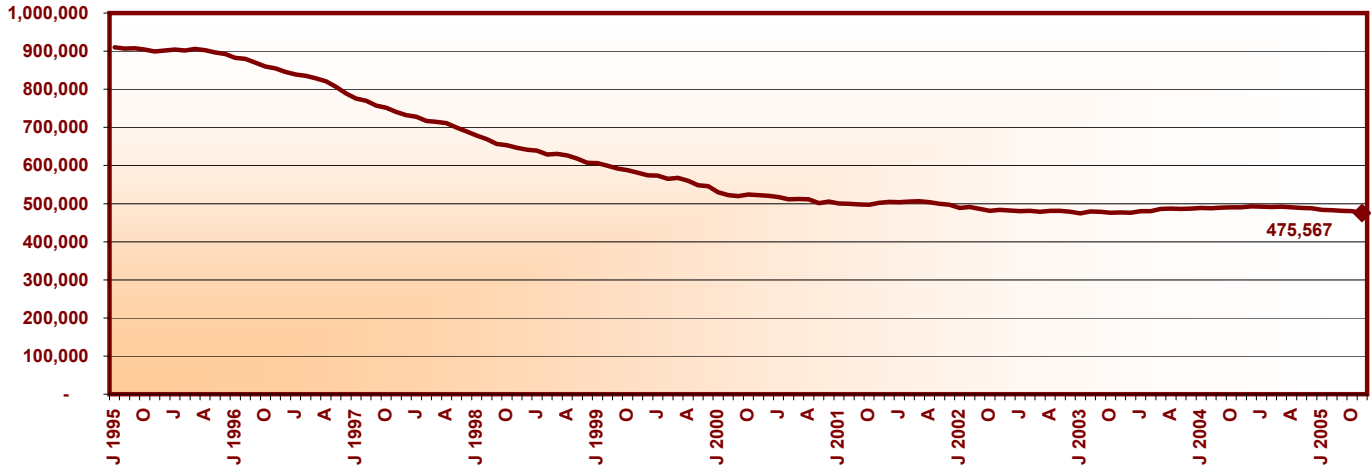

Monthly Caseload Trend Graphs with Current Month Value Displayed

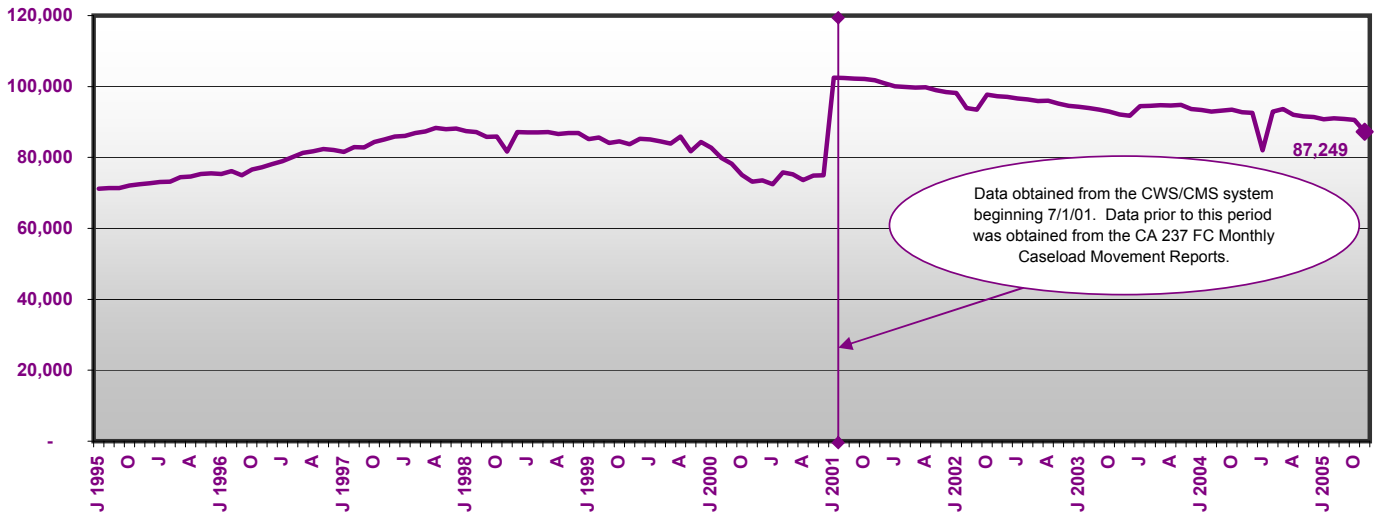

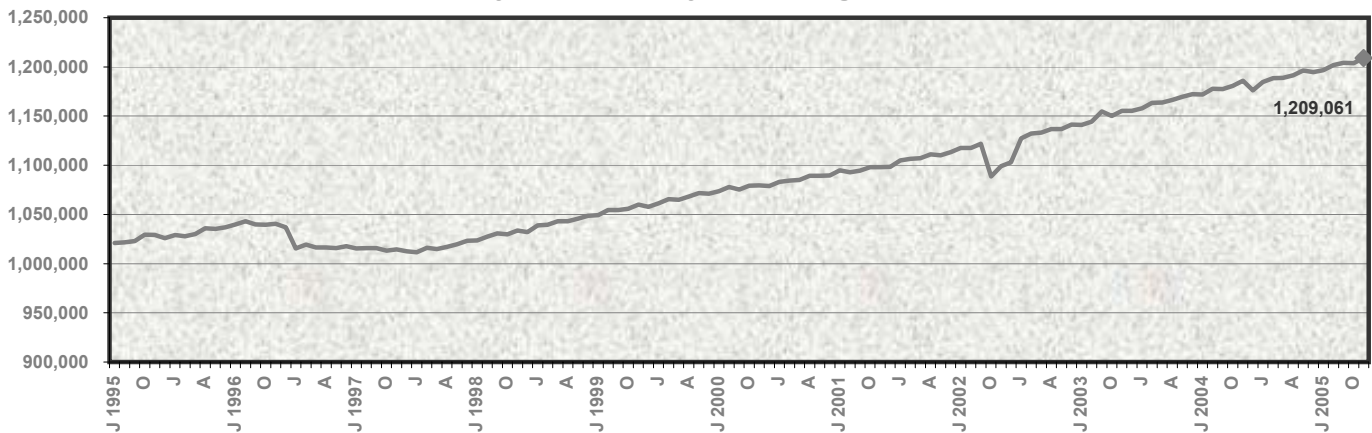
AFDC/CalWORKs Monthly Caseload - July 1995 through November 2005

SSI/SSP Monthly Caseload - July 1995 through November 2005



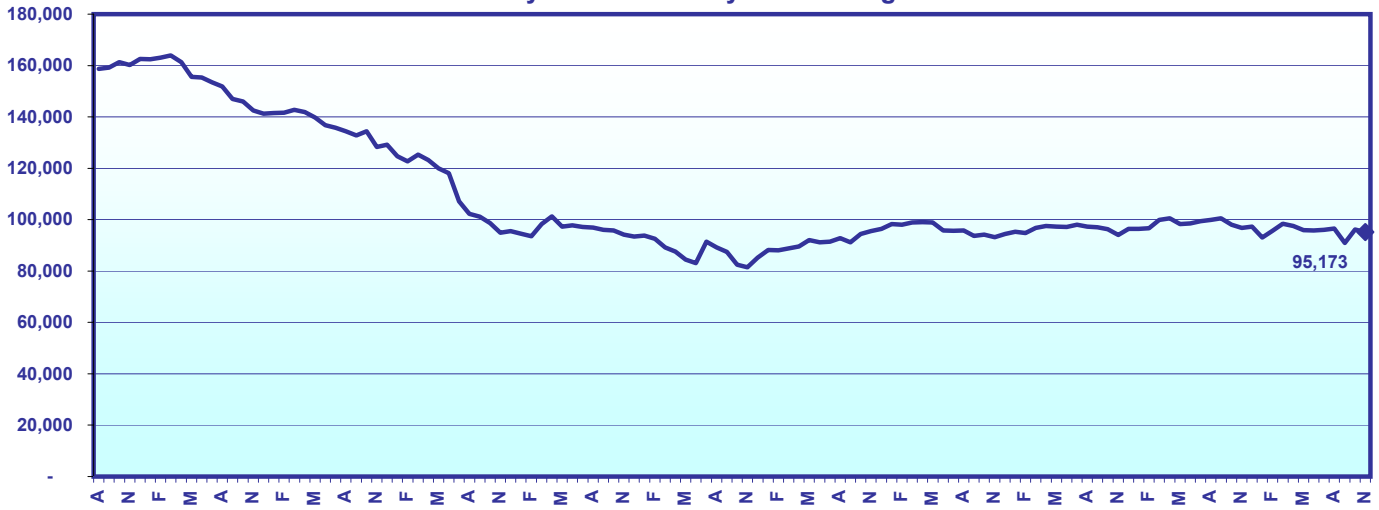
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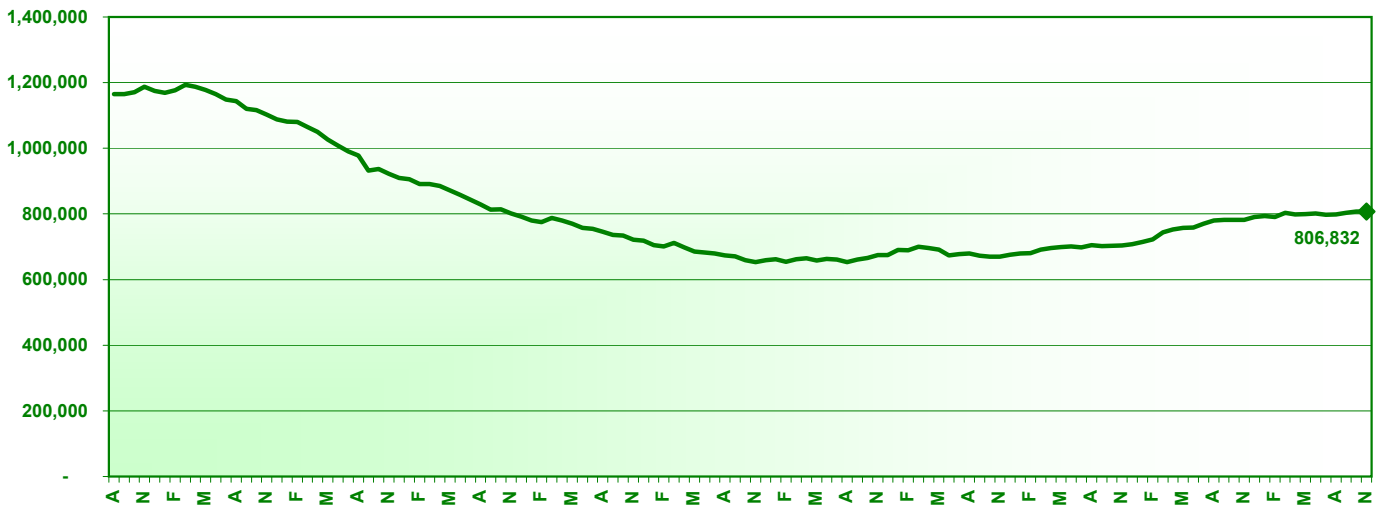
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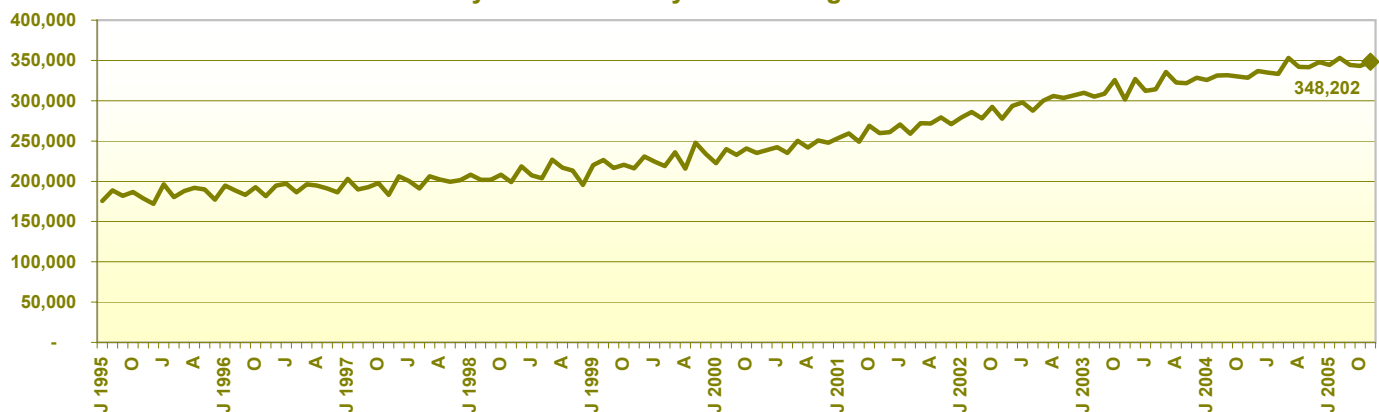
General Relief Monthly Caseload - July 1995 through November 2005
