**Calaveras:** WTW includes new clients added during the month - unable to get accurate break out due to computer system.

**Colusa:** CAPI count is done by the Sacramento Consortium and unable to get break out. (1)

**Imperial:** Under Social Services, Adult Services and Family Services are combined together under Title XX.

**Los Angeles:** Under Foster Care column, the county is unable to identify (66) Ethnic Origin case counts.

**Placer:** CAPI count is done by the Sacramento Consortium and unable to get break out. (10)

**Orange:** \*CalWORKs, Foster Care, WTW and RCA cases from the CalWIN data system with ethnicity not given as a category in the ABCD 350 report were assigned to the largest ethnic origin category for each program.

**Riverside:** Page 1, cell 199, unable to identify 68 Ethnic cases. page 2, cell 559, unable to identify 73 Language spoken cases. This is not a required field in State designed CMS system. Under Social Services column, the county is unable to identify (120) Ethnic Origin case counts and (108) Primary Language Spoken case counts; Ethnic Origin and Primary Language data are not required fields in the State designed CMS system.

**Santa Barbara:** County did not explain why the CAPI count cannot be broken out on this report.

**San Bernardino:** Part A. Ethnic Origin: Column B: There are 6 cases where the ethnic origin is Other or Not Selected. Column G: There are 134 cases where the Ethnic Origin is unknown to San Bernardino County.

**Trinity:** The 2 case difference between the CalWORKs Two-Parent and the WTW Two Parent is there are 2 cases both parents in the home are sanctioned from WTW.

**Yuba:** CAPI count is done by the Sacramento Consortium and unable to get break out. (5)

**Monterey:** Under Social Services: language unknown. In CAPI column, per San Mateo Consortium: Hindi and Punjabi.
