TRENDS

NOTE: The number of Federal households is the total Federal-Only households plus the Federal share of combined households (households which include federally eligible and California Food Assistance Program [CFAP] eligible persons). The Federal share of combined households is calculated using a proration based on the number of Federal and CFAP persons in combined households.

- CalFresh annual average households increased 4.8% between FY 13/14 and FY 14/15.
 - PA households decreased 3.0% between FY 13/14 and FY 14/15.
 - NA households increased 6.3% between FY 13/14 and FY 14/15.

The number of Non-Public Assistance households now exceeds the number of Public Assistance households by 1,485,227 households.

The ratio of Public Assistance and Non-Public Assistance and 85.7% Non-Public Assistance in FY 13/14 to 14.3% Public Assistance and 85.7% Non-Public Assistance in FY 14/15.
