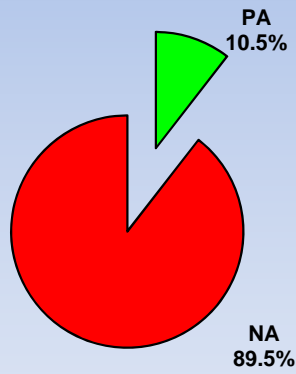
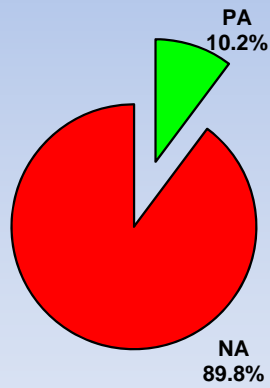


**California Food Assistance Program (CFAP)

TRENDS

NOTE: The number of CFAP households is the total CFAP-Only households plus the CFAP share of combined households (households which include federally eligible and CFAP eligible persons). The CFAP share of combined households is calculated using a proration based on the number of Federal and CFAP persons in combined households.

- CFAP annual average households increased 12.8% between FY 13/14 and FY 14/15.
PA households increased 9.8% between FY 13/14 and FY 14/15.
NA households increased 13.2% between FY 13/14 and FY 14/15.
- In September 1997, the CFAP was implemented to provide CalFresh benefits to a portion of the legal non-citizens who were excluded from participation in the Supplemental Nutritional Assistance Program (SNAP) by Federal law.
- In September 1998, CFAP regulations were changed to expand the categories of legal immigrants who could participate in CFAP.
- Effective April 2003 and October 2003, eligibility rule changes allowed certain CFAP recipients to convert to the CalFresh program.

a/ PA: all members of the CF h/h also receive cash assistance.

b/ NA: none or just some of the CF h/h receives cash assistance.
