What is Fresh Success?

 CalFresh Employment & Training programs with California community colleges and community-based organizations



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How is the Program Funded?

- Employment & Training providers receive partial reimbursement for the services they provide
- The amount of federal reimbursement depends upon the provider's available non-federal funding

Example: Provider spends \$1.00 on allowable program cost, the USDA then reimburses \$0.50.



What Qualifies for Reimbursement?

- Non-federal funds that
 - are not already being used as match for another federal program
 - are being spent on <u>allowable</u> services to <u>qualifying</u> participants

Allowable Services

- CTE courses and programs
- HS equivalency
- ESL
- Case management
- Supportive services (transportation, textbooks, etc.)

Qualifying Participants

- CalFresh recipient
- not in CalWORKs



What Types of Non-Federal Funding Can be Used?

- Possible sources of non-federal funding include
 - California Adult Education Program state funding
 - Strong Workforce state funding
 - Philanthropic funds
 - Other state/local funds



What Related Services are Offered through Adult Education?

- Adult Basic & Secondary Education
- English as a Second Language & Citizenship
- Career Technical Education
- Workforce Reentry
- Pre-Apprenticeship



How is Adult Education Funded?



- Adult Education funding jointly led by
 - California Community College Chancellor's Office
 - California Department of Education
- K-12 and community colleges
- 400 members and more than 1,000 community partners within 71 regional consortia



How can Fresh Success Help Engage Adult Education Providers?

- In counties that partner with Fresh Success:
 - Reach out to potential providers
 - Offer tools, training, and technical assistance
 - Contract directly with providers
 - Facilitate partnership between the provider and County
 - Act as a liaison with state and federal E&T agencies

Adult Education Funding and Strong Workforce Program

Funding

- \$248M annually
- <u>7 Regional Consortia</u>
- Local: 60%
- Regional: 40%

- Improve Program Quality (better)
