

## Project Roomkey: Food Resources

### ***World Central Kitchen***

The Department of General Services executed an emergency master services contract with World Central Kitchen (WCK) to provide food service operations statewide for any COVID 19 needs, including Project Roomkey. The MSA provides local governments\* the opportunity to acquire services in accordance with the instructions provided and the terms and conditions outlined in the MSA.

WCK has agreed to provide the following services at a cost of \$13 - \$20 (not to exceed \$20/day), to be customized locally:

- 3 pre-packaged meals per day, hot or cold to residents, patients and support staff
- Meal preparation and delivery to statewide locations
- Accommodate dietary restrictions and size scaling for adults and children
- Coordinate with local restaurants and catering companies for additional workforce support

*\*Per Public Contract Codes 10298 (a)(b) and 10299 (a)(b) Local government agencies are defined as “any city, county, city and county, district or other local governmental body or corporation, and any school district”, empowered to expend public funds for the acquisition of goods, information technology or services.*
