**PURPOSE**

The purpose of this ACL is to provide the sharing ratios for the following foster care placements: Foster Family Agencies (FFA), Intensive Services Foster Care (ISFC), Short-Term Residential Therapeutic Programs (STRTP), Community Treatment Facilities (CTF) and Transitional Housing Placement for Nonminor Dependents (THP-NMD). The sharing ratios correlate with the program rates listed in [ACL 22-59](#), and should be used in conjunction with each other. The sharing ratios in this letter are used by counties to identify the non-federal portion of their payments when they are claiming expenditures.

### **FFA SHARING RATIOS**

Effective July 1, 2022 (Fiscal Year (FY) 2022-23), the sharing ratios in Tables A and B will be applied to the FFA programs.
