Pre-register* for Disaster CalFresh food benefits by calling or texting **1-916-237-1909** between **October 7 and October 13.**

Wait for the county to contact you. Your county will call you to complete the application and interview between October 14 and October 22.

3

Pick up your EBT card. If you are approved for Disaster CalFresh food benefits, your county will tell you when and where to pick up your EBT card, which you'll use like a debit card to purchase food.
