SUBJECT: **TEMPORARY MANAGEMENT OF ADULT COMMUNITY CARE FACILITIES AND RESIDENTIAL CARE FACILITIES FOR THE ELDERLY EMERGENCY REGULATIONS MADE PERMANENT**

Provider Information Notice (PIN) Summary

PIN 19-10-ASC announces the permanent adoption of California Code of Regulations, Title 22, Division 6, Chapter 10 Temporary Management of Adult Community Care Facilities and Residential Care Facilities for the Elderly.

Effective April 03, 2019, California Code of Regulations (CCR), Title 22, Division 6, Chapter 10 [Temporary Management of Adult Community Care Facilities and Residential Care Facilities for the Elderly](#) is permanently adopted.

Since the emergency regulations were adopted on August 22, 2018, the California Department of Social Services amended the following regulation sections of CCR, Title 22, Division 6, Chapter 10:

Section 89633(a) - Temporary Manager Appointment

This section is amended to require the appointment notice include the number of nonambulatory residents, the number of bedridden residents unable to turn or reposition in bed, the number of residents on hospice, a list of deficiencies from inspection reports that have led to the need for a temporary manager and if the facility is in financial distress.

Section 89667 - Temporary Manager Qualifications

This section is amended to remove the requirement for a temporary manager who is an individual to have an associate degree or bachelor's degree in fields related to social services, health, and/or business management.

Section 89602(b) and (c) - Description of Forms

The "Temporary Manager Candidate List Applicant Information" form and "Temporary Manager Appointment Applicant Information" form is updated to reflect the amendment in Section 89667(a) which removed the qualification requirement for a temporary manager to have an associate degree or bachelor's degree in fields related to social services, health, and/or business management. The revision date of the forms are updated to 11/18.
