This addendum is to update section (m) of the county's CalWORKs plan to indicate that job retention services will be provided for participants who become ineligible for CalWORKs cash assistance due to income from subsidized employment, including Expanded Subsidized Employment. This addendum also clarifies wording for the county's existing job retention services.

Addendum May 2015

(m) ASSISTING FAMILIES TRANSITIONING OFF AID

Del Norte County plans to assist families transitioning off aid due to time limits or due to employment (including subsidized employment) by providing the following Supportive Services: Child Care, Ancillary and Transportation. Families whose CalWORKs cash assistance discontinues as a result of income from Subsidized Employment, shall be entitled to Supportive Services for the duration of the Subsidized Employment placement.

Upon enrollment in CalWORKs, a family will receive Stage I Child Care services. Once they have completed Stage I or have demonstrated stability, they will be referred to Stage II. Prior to completing Stage I, a transition plan will be arranged describing their new child care status and responsibilities. Once eligibility for Stage II has expired, an eligible family will be transferred to a local CDE funded program. However, families participating in Subsidized Employment will remain eligible for Stage I child care for the duration of the Subsidized Employment placement.

Case management services will include referral to appropriate agencies and support groups. Transportation and Ancillary Supportive Services will be provided on a limited basis and based on available funding. However, Transportation and Ancillary Supportive Services will be available to individuals participating in Subsidized Employment for the duration of the placement and participation in a Subsidized Employment program.
