(D) Welfare-To-Work Activities

The welfare-to-work activities discussed in this section are allowed by the Welfare-to-Work Act (WTW) of 1997 AB 1542 and the TANF Final Rule 2008. The Riverside County CalWORKs Program will use the following WTW activities for all customers:

- Unsubsidized employment
- Job Search and Job Readiness Assistance
- Self-Employment
- Homework Time for education and training activities

The Riverside County CalWORKs Program will use the following eleven WTW activities in a more limited way on a case-by-case basis:

- Work Experience
- On-the-Job Training
- Adult Basic Education
- Work-Study
- Community Service
- Job Skills Training Directly Related to Employment
- Vocational Education and Training
- Education Directly Related to Employment
- Supported Work
- Subsidized Private Sector Employment
- Subsidized Public Sector Employment

The Riverside County CalWORKs Program will not, at this time, use the following two WTW activities:

- Grant-Based On-the-Job Training
- Transitional Employment
