NOTICE: ALL ITEMS MUST BE IN COMPLIANCE PRIOR TO THE PRE-LICENSING VISIT. Failure to have these items corrected will result in rescheduling the visit and delaying the processing of your application.

	80028	Employee accommodations must be considered in determining the building arrangements, taking into consideration the type of staffing arrangements to be used. Shift staff, live-in staff, etc.		
	80073	An operating telephone on the premises and available to clients.		
	80074	Vehicles used to transport clients must be maintained in a safe operating condition.		
	80075	First-aid supplies, which include sterile first-aid dressings, bandages, adhesive tapes, scissors, tweezers, thermometer, antiseptic solution, and a current first-aid manual, must be maintained.

	85088	A sufficient supply of linens to permit weekly changing or more often to insure clean linens at all times for clients.		
	85088	Equipment and supplies for client personal hygiene is available and on site.		
	85088	Activity supplies are available for clients.		
	85088	For facilities of 16 or more or facilities having separate floors/buildings without full time staff, signal systems are required.

	Administrator's records, employees and client records must be maintained at the facility and available for review by the analyst as employees are hired and clients accepted into the facility.
