SUBJECT: GUIDANCE ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE AFFORDABLE CARE ACT OF 2010

REFERENCE: ALL COUNTY INFORMATION NOTICE (ACIN) I-37-13

The purpose of this All County Information Notice (ACIN) is to provide counties and stakeholders with recently published Medi-Cal Eligibility Division Letters (MEDIL) that relate to the Affordable Care Act of 2010.

Interoperability between programs is an essential goal that has been emphasized with the implementation of the Affordable Care Act 2010. This concept provides a seamless experience for customers and streamlines existing processes. As part of the California Department of Social Services (CDSS) continuous effort to coordinate human services programs (also known as “Horizontal Integration”) the Department is sending ACINs containing MEDIL communications to additional stakeholders and counterparts.
