SUBJECT: CALIFORNIA WORK OPPORTUNITY AND RESPONSIBILITY TO KIDS (CalWORKs): FINAL REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT ASSEMBLY BILL (AB) 1712 AND AB 212 NON-MINOR DEPENDENTS (NMDs)

REFERENCE: AB 1712 (CHAPTER 846, STATUTES OF 2012); AB 212 (CHAPTER 459, STATUTES OF 2011); WELFARE AND INSTITUTIONS CODE SECTIONS 11253(b)(2) AND 11253(c); FAMILY CODE SECTIONS 17552(e) AND 17552(f); ALL COUNTY LETTER (ACL) NOS. 13-10 and 12-27.

The purpose of this letter is to transmit final regulations affecting extended CalWORKs for Non-Minor Dependents (NMDs) due to the enactment of Assembly Bill (AB) 1712 and AB 212. These regulations were issued on an emergency basis, effective September 30, 2013, and implemented through ACL 13-10, dated February 7, 2013, and ACL 12-27, dated June 12, 2012. The attached final regulations were approved by the Office of Administrative Law and certified by the Secretary of State on April 23, 2014. ## **NEW OR AMENDED CALWORKS REGULATIONS**

Changes to the CalWORKs program regulations resulting from AB 1712 and AB 212 include the following:

### Statewide Fingerprint Imaging System (SFIS)

- Exempts NMDs from the SFIS requirements (MPP Section 40-105.333).

### Out-of-State

- Exempts NMDs from the California residency requirement when placed with an approved relative who resides out-of-state (MPP Section 42-422.21).

### Child Support

- Exempts parents of NMDs over age 19 from referral to the local child support agency for child support payments (MPP Section 82-504.141).
- Exempts parenting NMDs who reside with their children in foster care from referral to the local child support agency for the payment of child support (MPP Section 82-504.142).

.2 Exemptions from residency requirement in 42-422.1 are as follows:

.21 A non-minor dependent placed with an approved relative who resides out-of-state.
