This letter informs counties that the United States Department of Agriculture, FNS has issued the Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2015 Disaster Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (D-SNAP) Income Eligibility Standards and Allotments for the period of October 1, 2014 through September 30, 2015.

The computation below shows how FNS computes the Disaster Gross Income limits for a one person household:

Maximum Monthly Net Income Limit for household size of one (100% of FPL)	\$973
Maximum Standard Income Deduction	+ \$155
Maximum Shelter Expense Deduction	+ \$490
Disaster Gross Income Limit	= \$1618

¹ These figures include all necessary calculations. For example, for a 1-person household In the 48 States and DC, the maximum net monthly income = \$973; standard deduction = \$155; maximum shelter deduction = \$490. \$973 +\$155 + \$490 = \$1618.
