This ACIN provides a brief background on the ETO software system that is the new format to capture Annual Reporting data from counties. It also provides information on the upcoming training webinars to be held throughout the month of May 2015.

Background

Over the years, the OCAP has collected Annual Report information from counties through tedious Excel documents, lengthy Word documents and most recently, through multiple Survey Monkey questionnaires. In an effort to improve customer service, streamline processes and improve the accuracy and quality of data collected for federal reporting purposes, the OCAP acquired the ETO software system.

ETO is a web-based performance management software system that will be utilized for OCAP’s annual reporting of prevention funded (CBCAP, PSSF, CAPIT, and CTF) services. ETO will replace the numerous surveys previously completed by counties and provide dynamic, real-time reporting. With ETO, there will be no calculations, and no spreadsheets to fill-out. Counties will be able to more easily and readily access their allocation figures and report summaries. By participating in the training webinars, counties will learn in detail about the new OCAP reporting process.

The OCAP anticipates **ETO will be live and available to counties to begin training on May 1st**. Each staff person who registers for the training will receive log-in information. The OCAP requests that **only the staff** responsible for OCAP's Annual Report take one of the ten trainings offered in the month of May. Once county staff responsible for the FY 2014-2015 Annual Report have completed the training, he/she can begin using the software system and inputting data.
