This erratum to <u>CFL No. 14/15-23</u> provides updated instructions for the claiming of Commercially Sexually Exploited Children (CSEC) program administrative costs. As stated in <u>CFL No. 14/15-23</u>, expenses for CSEC Protocol and Development should be claimed to program code (PC) 920 - CSEC PROGRAM PROTOCOL AND DEVELOPMENT. The PC 920 is subject to the Title IV-E non-federal discount rate. As stated in <u>CFL No. 12/13-24</u>, the Title IV-E non-federal discount rate is the state's federally-approved methodology for identifying and allocating costs to the benefiting programs. The amount of cost that is allocable to the Title IV-E PCs is adjusted to reflect the proportion of activity related to Title IV-E eligible children through application of the Title IV-E non-federal discount rate.

The non-federal discount PC was inadvertently omitted from CFL No. 14/15-23.

The State Use Only (SUO) code 915 – CSEC NON-FEDERAL DISCOUNT has been established to capture the non-federal share of costs claimed to PC 920. All other claiming information related to the CSEC program remains unchanged.
