This letter informs counties of a funding redistribution of \$23.7 million in federal Temporary Assistance for Needy Families funds and General Fund in the Fiscal Year (FY) 2015-16 allocation for the California Work Opportunity and Responsibility to Kids (CalWORKs) Single Allocation (SA) Program. These funds are being redistributed as requested by the County Welfare Directors Association (CWDA). The CWDA determined the redistribution of funding amongst counties to ensure the maximum expenditure rate of available funds.

Attachment I displays the redistribution of FY 2015-16 funds for the CalWORKs SA Program. Attachment II exhibits a listing of Program Codes (PC) available for claiming to the CalWORKs SA program.

Expenditures charged against these PCs are tracked against the CalWORKs SA ledger on the quarterly County Expense Claim.
